**Key Passage to Memorize & Meditate Upon: Psalm 2:1-6 (LSB)** Why do the nations rage and the peoples meditate on a vain thing? <sup>2</sup> The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers take counsel together against Yahweh and against His Anointed, saying, <sup>3</sup> “Let us tear their fetters apart and cast away their cords from us!” <sup>4</sup> He who sits in the heavens laughs, the Lord mocks them. <sup>5</sup> Then He speaks to them in His anger and terrifies them in His fury, saying, <sup>6</sup> “But as for Me, I have installed My King upon Zion, My holy mountain.”
