Key Passage to Memorize & Meditate Upon: Rev. 19:11-16 (LSB) Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sits on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. ¹² His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems; having a name written on Him which no one knows except Himself, ¹³ and being clothed with a garment dipped in blood, His name is also called The Word of God. ¹⁴ And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses. ¹⁵ And from His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the wrath of the rage of God, the Almighty. ¹⁶ And He has on His garment and on His thigh a name written, “KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.”
