Key Passage to Memorize & Meditate Upon: Eph 4:1-6 (LSB) Therefore I, the prisoner in the Lord, exhort you to walk worthy of the calling with which you have been called,² with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,³ being diligent to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.⁴ There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling;⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism;⁶ one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.
