Key Passage to Memorize & Meditate Upon: Heb 1:8-12 (LSB) But of the Son He says, “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, and the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom.”⁹ “You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness above Your companions.”¹⁰ And, “You, Lord, in the beginning founded the earth, and the heavens are the works of Your hands;¹¹ They will perish, but You remain; and they all will wear out like a garment,¹² and like a mantle You will roll them up; like a garment they will also be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will not come to an end.”
