Key Passage to Memorize & Meditate Upon: Isa 40:5-8 (LSB) Then the glory of Yahweh will be revealed, and all flesh will see it together; for the mouth of Yahweh has spoken.”⁶ A voice says, “Call out.” Then he answered, “what shall I call out?” All flesh is grass, and all its lovingkindness is like the flower of the field.⁷ The grass withers, the flower fades, when the breath of Yahweh blows upon it; surely the people are grass.⁸ The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God stands forever.
