# What Is Church Membership?

What are the businesses or organizations you have a membership with? Sam's Club? COSTCO? A local gym? Amazon? How do such memberships work? Usually there is a fee paid, which once paid, you get access to perks and discounts that others do not have access to. As good as these benefits of being a member are, this is NOT how church membership works. How is it different?

- It is covenantal, not contractual our church has a covenant that summarizes what Scripture teaches on how Christians ought to relate to one another. Although you will not find the Bible explicitly commanding churches to have a church covenant, the New Testament implies that there is a mutual understanding Christians have within a local church of how they are to relate with one another and live out their faith (see Heb 10:23-25, 13:17-18). It is more than just an agreement to perform a particular service, after which the relationship ceases, such as is case with a contract.
- It is relational, not transactional our church covenant calls us as members to relate in such a way that commends the gospel and makes much of Jesus Christ. Therefore, we are to practice the "one anothers" of Scripture for our growth and for God's glory. It is not a mere exchange of goods and services such as in any transaction. It is not a "you scratch my back and I'll scratch your back." Rather, its "I've got your back and you have my back."
- It is sacrificial, not consumeristic our church covenant calls us as members to lay down our lives for one another. This fights against the cultural current of putting me at the center of the universe by asking "what can I get out of this?" Rather, it puts God at the center and we express that by loving one another. This is the path that Jesus blazed for us to walk. This is the mind we are to have in how we relate to one another (Phil 2:5).

This Sunday, we will have the opportunity to receive a number of brothers and sisters in Christ into membership. As we do this, we will "joyfully renew our covenant with each other." Let's do so with these thoughts in mind thanking God for the sweet fellowship we share with Him and with one another here at Bethel. Grace and peace,
