# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### 1. Who can attend?

- Any student who is currently in 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade
- 2. What are the dates?

# 4. How much does it cost?

- \$100 per student (includes all meals, lodging, activities, giveaways, etc.)
  - a. Payment and forms must be received by Sunday, December 29th.
- 5. How can I register?
  - Registration forms can be picked up in the youth room or at <u>blueskychurch.com/refresh</u>
  - Forms can be turned in at the following locations
    - a. Offering basket during service or black offering box (i.e. back of auditorium)
    - b. Weekly at youth group
- 6. When do I need to drop off my student? When will they return?
  - Check-in begins at 8:30 AM on Saturday. The bus will be leaving Blue Sky shortly after.
  - We will return to Blue Sky around 2:30 PM on Monday Jan. 15th.

# 7. WHAT TO PACK

- Bedding and pillow (twin size beds)
  - o no bedding is provided
- Bible, Notebook, pen
- Water Bottle
- Snacks
- Clothing for 2 nights/2 days
- Toiletries (Deodorant, soap, shampoo, toothpaste/brush, etc)
- Towels
- Athletic/warm clothes for outdoor activities
  - Outdoor activities include zip lining, rock climbing, horseback riding and a bonfire
- Tennis Shoes (closed toe) for outdoor activities
- Laundry bag for messy clothes

- Tobacco products/alcohol/drugs\*
- Lighters/Matches\*
- Fireworks \*
- Weapons\*

\*Possession of these items will result in your student being sent home & picked up at your expense.
