## Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who can attend?
  - Any student who is currently in 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade
2. What are the dates?
  - Saturday Jan 17<sup>th</sup> - Monday Jan. 19<sup>th</sup> (MLK Weekend)
3. Where is the Retreat?

4. How much does it cost?
  - \$100 per student (includes all meals, lodging, activities, giveaways, etc.)
    - a. *Payment and forms must be received by Sunday, December 29th.*
5. How can I register?

  - Forms can be turned in at the following locations
    - a. Black offering box (i.e. back of auditorium)
6. When do I need to drop off my student? When will they return?
  - Check-in begins at 8:30 AM on Saturday. The bus will be leaving Blue Sky shortly after.
  - We will return to Blue Sky around 2:30 PM on Monday Jan. 15th.
7. WHAT TO PACK
  - **Bedding and pillow** (twin size beds)
    - o *no bedding is provided*
  - Bible, Notebook, pen
  - Water Bottle
  - Snacks
  - Clothing for 2 nights/2 days
  - Toiletries (Deodorant, soap, shampoo, toothpaste/brush, etc)
  - Towels
  - Athletic/warm clothes for outdoor activities
    - o Outdoor activities include zip lining, rock climbing, horseback riding and a bonfire
  - Tennis Shoes (closed toe) for outdoor activities
  - Laundry bag for messy clothes
8. WHAT **NOT** TO PACK
  - ANY electronic gaming device
  - Tobacco products/alcohol/drugs\*
  - Lighters/Matches\*
  - Fireworks \*
  - Weapons\*

\*Possession of these items will result in your student being sent home & picked up at your expense.

9. Will my student be able to use their cell phone during camp?

- Unless you specifically request for your child to have their phone on them, no. We believe this retreat has the potential to be life-changing and we want to eliminate anything that might be a distraction to our students focusing on God and building relationships with others. If you would like your student to have their cell phone, please let us know ahead of time.
