- (1) When you sing the song, King of My Heart, and especially the words, "He's never gonna' let, never gonna' let me down," do you wonder if it's true? Why? What do you think these words mean?
- (2) What is the purpose of God sealing his saints? What is the seal itself? In what ways does this apply to you and me in terms of how we should approach our daily struggles and battles as God's children?
- (3) Is the "seal" of God on the foreheads of his people a literal tattoo of some sort? If not, why not? How does this help us understand the meaning of the "mark" of the Beast? What have you been taught in the past about this "mark"? How do you understand its meaning now?
- (4) What reasons are there to conclude that the 144,000 and the innumerable multitude are one and the same group of individuals, the people of God from all ages, whether Jewish or Gentile?
- (5) Read Romans 8:35-39. How might it be that this passage is Paul's description of the truth we read in Revelation 7?
