4. Invest and engage relationally with students and build relationships and partnerships with local schools and sports teams to help engage and support local youth programs.
5. Provide biblical counseling and spiritual direction to Youth, Children, Parents, and Volunteers and students as needed.
6. Developing students into leaders empowering them to take ownership of their ministry by serving where gifted.
7. Explore and implement outreach events to connect students and families in the local community to our church community.
