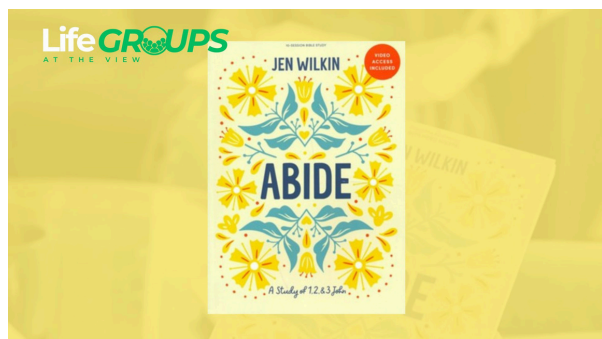

Class Format: Online Only

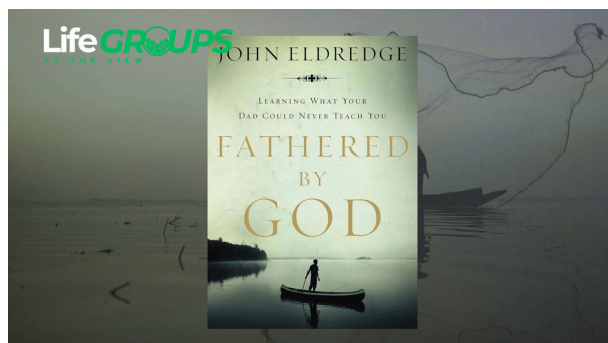
What to Expect: Small group in-depth study that answers questions like: How can we hold onto assurance of our faith? How can we discern the truth from a lie? How can we know God loves us?

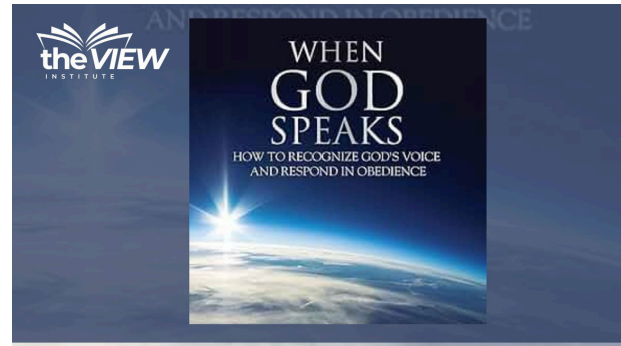


TH 102 - OVERCOMING DEPRESSION: WALKING FROM DARKNESS INTO THE DAWN

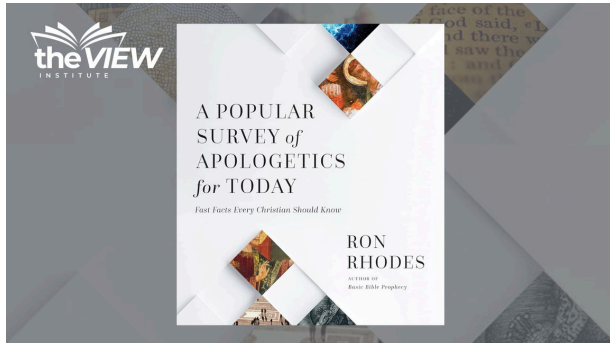

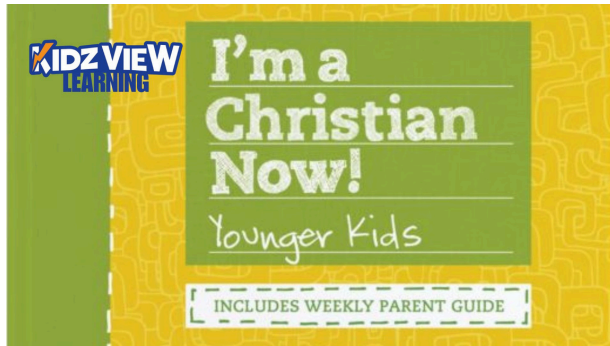
