



CALVARY BOISE

The Calvary Chapel Boise **Premarital program** is designed to help couples pursue a godly marriage. God's Word provides a blueprint for building and maintaining solid, enduring, spiritually connected relationships. In order to better serve you we would like to make you aware of the premarital process (*eight sessions and can take up to four months*).

1. Due to the number of weddings that are performed at Calvary Chapel Boise, use of the church facilities is limited to couples whereby at least one member regularly attends Calvary Chapel Boise's church services.
2. Attached to this letter are the Premarital Request Forms (Applications). In order to effectively complete the program the Premarital Request Forms need to be thoroughly completed and returned to the office at least four months prior to the couple's wedding date.
3. After the completed application has been returned we will contact you within one week of the reception of both applications in order to set up an appointment for you both to meet with one of our pastors.

They will share with you the prerequisites for the discipleship program, which are as follows:

- You both agree to make a commitment to maintain sexual purity throughout your engagement and into marriage (as is defined by The Bible).
 - You both agree to live separately up until you are married.
 - You both agree to give God's Word, The Bible, authority over your relationship. (We also recommend you purchase the book entitled, "Preparing for Marriage" (Forward by Dennis Rainey) prior to your appointment with the pastor and bring it with you to the meeting.)
4. Should you agree to these terms we will then check the availability of the ordained Calvary Chapel Boise Officiant of your choice/ the church's availability. At the same time you will also be connected with a discipleship couple that will work through the material in the "Preparing for Marriage" book with you.
 5. Lastly you will begin the process of meeting with your assigned discipleship couple every week/ every other week until you both complete the material. All premarital material must be completed prior to the wedding. **The time needed to successfully go through premarital discipleship is three-four months.**

NOTE: Please be prepared to discuss the following topic during your meeting with a pastor:

- Pornography
- Opposite sex friendships and social media

These can be and have been a catalyst to inhibit intimacy in marriage and the development of the strongest emotional and spiritual bond possible.

CONSENT TO DISCIPLE

Our Goal – Our goal in providing Christian discipling is to help you meet the challenges of life in a way that will please and honor the Lord Jesus Christ and allow you to fully enjoy His love and plans for your life.

Biblical Basis – We believe that the Bible provides thorough guidance and instructions for faith and life. Therefore, our discipling is based on scriptural principles rather than those of secular psychology or psychiatry. Neither the pastoral nor the lay counselors of this church are trained or licensed as psychotherapist or mental health professionals.

Confidentiality – Confidentiality is an important aspect of the discipling process, and we will carefully guard the information you entrust to us. However, there are five situations when it may be necessary for us to share certain information with others. These situations are: (1) when a discipler is uncertain of how to address a particular problem and needs to seek advice from another pastor or elder in this church (2) when a disciple attends another church and it is necessary to talk with his or her pastor or elders (3) when there is a clear indication that someone may be harmed unless others intervene (4) when a person persistently refuses to renounce a particular sin and it becomes necessary to seek the assistance of others in the church to encourage repentance and reconciliation (5) when a crime has been committed (see Proverbs 15:22; Proverbs 24:11; Matthew 18:15-20; Deut.13:6-8). Please be assured that our disciplers strongly prefer not to disclose personal information to others, and they will make every effort to help you find ways to resolve a problem as privately as possible.

Conflict Resolution – On rare occasions a conflict may develop between a discipler and a disciple. In order to make sure that any such conflicts will be resolved in a biblical and faithful manner, we require all disciples to agree that any dispute that arises with a discipler or with this church as a result of discipleship will be settled by mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration.

Having clarified the principles and policies of our discipling ministry, we welcome the opportunity to minister to you in the name of Christ and to be used by Him as He helps you to grow in spiritual maturity and prepares you for usefulness in His body. If you have any questions about these guidelines, please talk with a pastor or elder before your appointment. If these guidelines are acceptable to you, please sign below.

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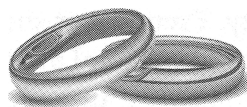
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Purity Covenant

Purity Covenant

Biblical Standard

1 Thessalonians 4:3-8: "For this is the will of God, your sanctification; that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality; that each of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God; and that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter because the Lord is the avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned you. For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification. So, he who rejects this is not rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you."

In obedience to God's command, I promise to protect your sexual purity from this day until our wedding night.

Biblical Standard

1 Corinthians 6:18-20: "Flee immorality. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body."

Because I respect and honor you, I commit to building up the inner person of your heart rather than violating you.

Biblical Standard

Acts 24:16: "In view of this, I also do my best to always maintain a blameless conscience both before God and before men."

I pledge to show my love for you in ways that allow both of us to maintain a clear conscience before God and each other.
