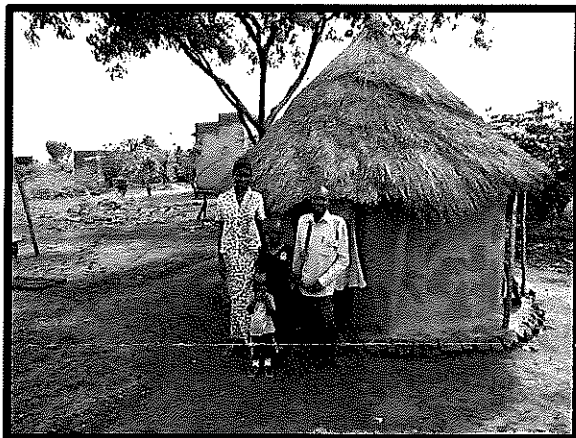

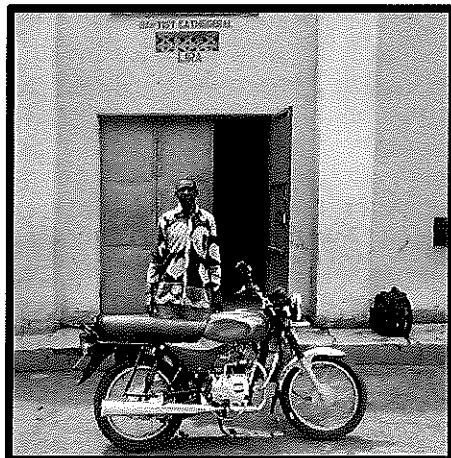


Friends: May the Lord Jesus Christ bless you and yours in His mercy and grace this month of July!

What a joy it is to preach the gospel to others. Please pray the Lord, the Holy Spirit, to make it effective in our hearers' hearts.

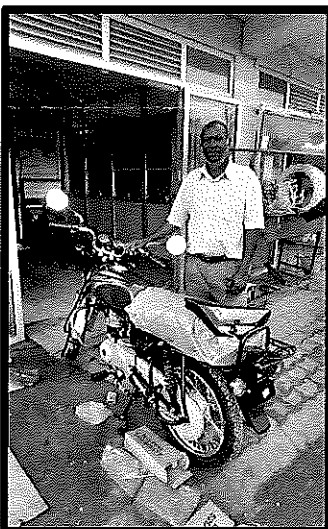
Please pray for God's mercies for Uganda, which is experiencing a third COVID 19 surge and has started another strict lockdown. This is a very difficult time for the people there now, as you see in this message from a Ugandan pastor: 'Prayers are needed for Uganda. COVID 19 infections and deaths are going up, and we are back in lockdown for 6 weeks again. Churches and schools are closed. Movements are restricted within districts. No one is allowed to travel beyond his home district or county. Some businesses closed. We are again faced with very hard and difficult days. Many families again are going to go hungry. This is terrible. Much prayer needed.'



We know several individuals who have contracted the virus; some are struggling to survive. Please pray for God's healing mercies for the people who are sick and who are suffering great hardships now with poor medical care, poverty, inability to work or travel for work. Pray that God will bring about less infections, good recoveries, less severe health issues, and save lives. Pray the people will comply with the government restrictions. We are helping with relief assistance for their present urgent needs. Pastor Clinton and his family are pictured in the top photo; they have been impacted by the virus; please pray for this family.

We had planned ministry in Uganda in Sept/Oct as I, Jim, would distribute Life Application Study Bibles and teach, preach and host 4 American visitors who would teach and serve the people. We had planned meetings to encourage church planting with unreached peoples groups in Uganda. Our plans for this trip are still a go at this point, but we wait to see what happens with the government restrictions in July.

Please pray that if God wills, Uganda's situation will quickly improve for all there. Pray that we can make this ministry trip as planned, as He wills.

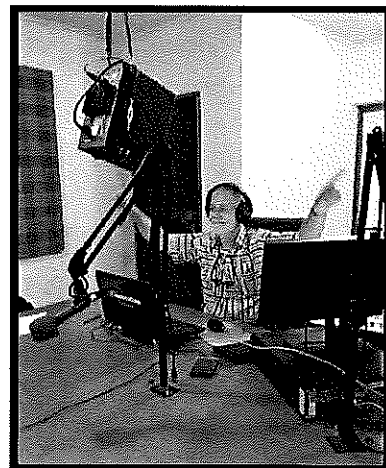
