#### MONDAY

Epistle Project: Colossians 2:6-15

Over and over again in Scripture, we see our salvation described the same way: we were dead. God made us alive. Yes, we repent and turn from our sin by choice. Yes, we exercise faith. But we repented and put our faith in Christ because God made us alive. Just as in Ephesians 2, here in Colossians 2 Paul says in verse 13, "You who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses." We were dead. God made us alive. And it is because he has done this that we now live by faith in him. We were saved by faith, and we live by faith. This is why Paul says in verse 6, "as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him." May God continue to change our hearts, giving spiritual renewal, so that we might have faith to walk in him.

## **TUESDAY**

Epistle Project: Colossians 2:16-23

In today's passage, Paul is highlighting some of the false teachings that the Colossians were dealing with. We may wish that we had more details as to what was going on, but Paul keeps his comments fairly general. Instead of narrowing in on the specifics of the false teaching, he takes it all back to Christ. When dealing with any false religion or false teaching, we must do the same. At the end of the day, how a person responds to Christ is of the ultimate importance. Center your life and your conversations on Christ and you can never go wrong.

WELCOME

Epistle Project: Colossians 3:1-17

At the beginning of this passage, a clear contrast is given and what our response is to be as Christians: "Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth," (v. 2). The mind is either set on the things of the world or it is set on the pursuit of a deeper knowledge of Christ. For the believer, the mind must be set on Christ and all that belongs to living for Him. The believer is to live in a way worthy of His name (Col. 1:10). Christians are to seek His kingdom first (Matt. 6:33). As Paul instructs the Colossians, he instructs us, to live in a manner that is pleasing to the Lord. Pray and ask the Lord to search your heart and to reveal areas where you are not living in a way that is pleasing to Him. Confess these things to Him knowing that "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness," (1 Jn. 1:9).

## **THURSDAY**

Epistle Project: Colossians 3:18-4:1

In all our roles in life, the scripture gives us clear and helpful guidance. Far too often, we do not live rightly simply because we do not go to the scripture for help. God has given us the true knowledge of his son in Scripture so that we would have "everything you need for life and godliness." In all your roles, look to scripture. Living by faith simply means hearing what God says, trusting that what he says is best, and living according to what he says. In Colossians 3, wives, husbands, children, fathers, employees (bondservants), and bosses (masters) all receive very clear, uncomplicated instructions. The Father's loving heart has given us helpful instruction. As we read these verses, let us meditate on our roles in life, and ask him how he would have us obey these verses. May we be quick to trust him and live by faith.

# Epistle Project: Colossians 4:2-6

It is estimated that the average person speaks over 15,000 words every day. That's a lot of words! This emphasizes the importance of communication and especially how we use those 15,000+ words. In today's passage, Paul is highlighting our speech. Our speaking to God in prayer must be continual and we must ask for opportunities to make the gospel clear. When speaking to others, our speech must always be wise and gracious. Let's use those 15,000+ words for the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ!

#### SATURDAY

Epistle Project: Colossians 4:7-18

"Tychicus will tell you all about my activities. He is a beloved brother and faithful minister and fellow servant in the Lord," (Col 4:7). Tychicus was a brother, a minister, and a servant. In these things, he was beloved, faithful, and a fellow. In one sentence we are given a beautiful picture of this believer and a clear example to follow. Pray and ask the Lord to give you a heart like Tychicus. Ask Him to shape your heart's desire to be a faithful and fellow servant.
