IT'S TIME TO DO GOD'S WILL

1 Peter 4:1-6

MONDAY

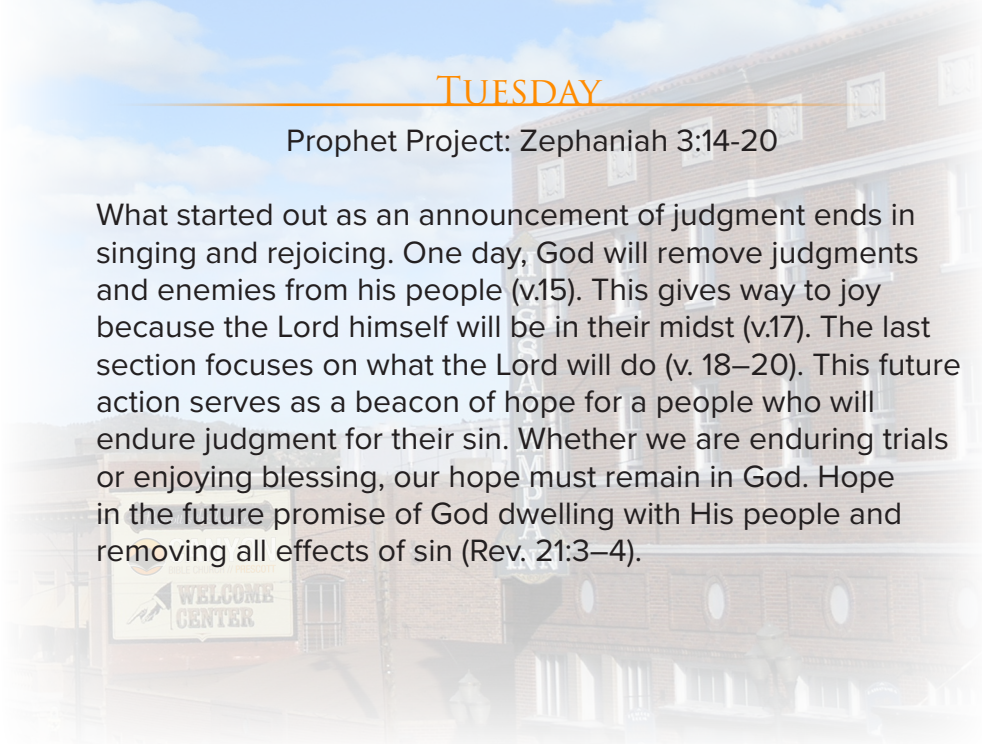
Prophet Project: Zephaniah 3:9-13

God is the Judge who also purifies and calls to Himself those of distant nations. God will change the speech of those who “call upon the name of the Lord,” and they will “serve him with one accord.” It is God who calls His people to Himself, and it is God who changes actions. The people go from impure speech to pure speech and to a people who desire to serve God. Praise God for the changes that He has brought about in your life. Ask the Lord to continue to change you so that you are more like Christ.

TUESDAY

Prophet Project: Zephaniah 3:14-20

What started out as an announcement of judgment ends in singing and rejoicing. One day, God will remove judgments and enemies from his people (v.15). This gives way to joy because the Lord himself will be in their midst (v.17). The last section focuses on what the Lord will do (v. 18–20). This future action serves as a beacon of hope for a people who will endure judgment for their sin. Whether we are enduring trials or enjoying blessing, our hope must remain in God. Hope in the future promise of God dwelling with His people and removing all effects of sin (Rev. 21:3–4).



WEDNESDAY

Prophet Project: Haggai 1:1-11

In this passage, the people reflect on a harvest season that was disappointing. They had struggled for personal gain, and it had been at the expense of the Lord's house. What they had hoped to gain was taken by the Lord. The Lord did this to teach them that the building of His house would bring Him glory. Bringing glory to God should have been their priority. We also must make bringing God glory a priority. We must be careful that we do not place other things, especially our own personal gain, before that of bringing glory to God.

FRIDAY

Prophet Project: Haggai 2:1-9

Today's passage contains the second message Haggai gave to those who had begun rebuilding the temple. God asked three questions to surface the people's comparison between Solomon's temple and the current state of the temple (v.3). The temple they were building was less grand than what was built before it. However, God encouraged His people to be strong and work (v.4). God shifts attention to a future time where He will fill the temple with glory and establish peace (v.9). One day God will rule and reign over His creation and establish his glory and peace.

THURSDAY

Prophet Project: Haggai 1:12-15

In verse 13 of today's passage, we read of God's promise "I am with you." This promise is one of covenantal assurance. The task that was before them would be undertaken with the promise that they will have the Lord's aid. We, too, know that the Lord is with us. This great promise is one that we can rest on because we know that the Lord always keeps His promises. Don't pass by promises of God in Scripture without praising Him for His faithfulness to His people.

SATURDAY

Prophet Project: Haggai 2:10-19

"Is the seed yet in the barn? Indeed, the vine, the fig tree, the pomegranate, and the olive tree have yielded nothing. But from this day on I will bless you," Haggai 2:19. Even though there was obedience, God is not obligated by it or to bless them because of it. God is making a promise that on "this day I will bless you." God is stating that although in previous years, there wasn't much to the harvest, there is a greater harvest to come. God is under no obligation to bless anyone with anything. God chooses to bless because He is a loving and gracious God. Praise Him for being so loving and gracious to you in your life and salvation.
