Thursday: Psalm 7

In the face of a difficult or possibly a desperate circumstance, the psalmist's first words here express trust in the Lord. It is God in whom they took refuge. Remember that your trust is to be in the Lord in a difficult circumstance and take refuge in Him.

Friday: Psalm 8

God not only made the heavens, the moon, and the stars, but He is also mindful of man and cares for him. God is not remote but is involved in every detail of His creation. Take time to praise God, the Creator, and that He is mindful of every detail of your life.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ in Nicaragua. Pray for courage and strength for the pastors and their families. Pray that the gospel would influence this country and that many would come to know Christ through the preaching of the Word.

Monday: Psalm 4

Verses 4 and 5 of today's passage are words to those who are godly. The godly are told not to give in to anger but to remain steadfast in worshiping and trusting the Lord. Pray that you would stay focused on your worship of and trusting in the Lord.

Tuesday: Psalm 5

"For you are not a God who delights in wickedness; evil may not dwell with you" (v. 4). The psalmist is praising God for loving what is right. Since God does not delight in wickedness, neither should we. Pray and ask the Lord to search your heart for anything that you might be delighting in that is wicked. Confess and repent of anything revealed.

Wednesday: Psalm 6

Verses 8 through 10 remind the believer that those genuinely sorry for and repentant over their sins can be assured that God hears them. God hears the plea and accepts the prayer of those with godly grief (2 Cor. 7:10).

Small Groups

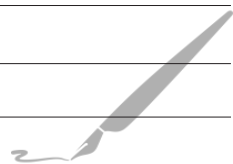

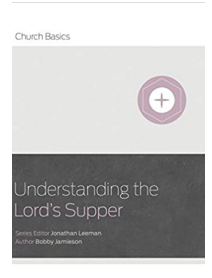
Sermon Application
