Thursday: Psalm 42

Just like a deer panting for streams of water, our souls are too long for God Himself. Does your soul thirst “for God, for the living God?” (v. 2). Ponder this and pray that God would stir in you a desire to thirst, to long for God more.

Friday: Psalm 43

“Listen to the psalmist talk to himself: ‘Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God’ (Ps. 43:5). This was a man in trouble. He felt threatened and overwhelmed. And in the first part of the psalm, he was doing exactly the right thing by pouring out his soul in prayer to God. But then he stopped praying and spoke directly to his soul.” - Jon Bloom

Saturday: Prayer

Keep praying for the Gospel Rescue Mission. Pray for the salvation of the guests at the Mission. Pray for those who need additional spiritual and financial assistance. Pray for more involvement in the Mission.

Monday: Psalm 39

“I said, ‘I will guard my ways, that I may not sin with my tongue; I will guard my mouth with a muzzle, so long as the wicked are in my presence’” (v. 1). The psalmist is carefully guarding what he says before the wicked. The lesson here is discerning what, how, and when to speak. Yet, like the psalmist, the faithful know they need to speak (v. 3), and speaking is a way of worship. Pray and ask the Lord to help you discern what you say so that your speech is a form of worship.

Tuesday: Psalm 40

Today’s Psalm combines thanksgiving for past mercies received from God and new instances of the need for God’s help. Both recognize that individual experiences of God’s grace and mercy lead to rejoicing in God.

Wednesday: Psalm 41

“Blessed is the one who considers the poor! In the day of trouble the Lord delivers him” (v. 1). Those who consider the poor are kind to them because they are fellow members of God’s people. This kindness refers to helping them in a generous way in which they cannot payback. God honors the person who shows such kindness in true faith.
