

"Be merciful to me, O God, be merciful to me" (v. 1). This request is a humble one asking for God to show kindness and to grant relief. The word could also be rendered as gracious. Pray and humbly ask that the Lord would be merciful and gracious to you.

Friday: Psalm 58

In the here and now, believers may suffer but know that God will judge the tyrants (v. 10). Those who are faithful know who their God is, a just God who loves to see His creation functioning correctly. Pray and praise the Lord, knowing that He is a righteous Judge and will judge the earth.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ in Nicaragua. Pray for courage and boldness to share Christ. Pray that the word of the Lord would be heard and that many would confess Christ and repent of sin.

Monday: Psalm 54

Every believer can trust that God is a helper and upholder of life (v. 4). The believer can trust that God "will return the evil to my enemies" (v. 5). The believer can place complete confidence in God and His timing. Pray and trust, knowing that "God is my helper" (v. 4).

Tuesday: Psalm 55

This Psalm is a prayer for God's help against enemies who hate the faithful. The psalmist is desperate that the Lord hears his prayer. He calls upon God, who He trusts will listen to him in his time of need. Cast your burdens on the Lord (v. 22). Pray to Him and trust that He hears you.

Wednesday: Psalm 56

Read verses 8-11 of this Psalm as a prayer to God, knowing that God is for you.


Sermon Application
