### Thursday: Psalm 97

Today's psalm also celebrates God's kingship over all creation. The focus is on the universal rule of God and the assurance of His final victory over evil and idolatry. So pray and praise the Lord as ruler over all, and because of that, we can be assured of victory.

### Friday: Psalm 98

Today's passage calls for God's people to sing aloud together in celebration. We celebrate the Lord's faithfulness to us in keeping His promises for God "has remembered his steadfast love and faithfulness" (v. 3). Whenever we sing together, whether it be Sunday s or any other time, sing in remembrance and praise of who God is, what He has done, and that He steadfast in His love and faithfulness.

### Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the Esplin's at Indian Bible College. Daniel and Corrine Esplin are on a 5,500-mile tour of the West and Midwest. Their goal is to recruit and enroll 15-20 new students from various tribes. Pray that the Lord will bless their efforts and that IBC will start the fall semester with a full student body.

**Monday: Psalm 94**

“The gist of the whole matter is this, the way to comfort is the way where God is to be found. Christian, the way for sustenance, strength, hope, and consolation is the way which leads thee to thy God. Trust ye in the Lord for ever, for in the Lord Jehovah there is everlasting strength.” C. H. Spurgeon on Psalm 94:19

**Tuesday: Psalm 95**

The Lord is a great God who is the King above all gods (v. 3). The worship offered to Him is to be a “joyful noise” where there is “thanksgiving” in “songs of praise” (v. 3). Sing to the Lord with praise! Sing in your heart with joy, thanksgiving, and adoration to the Lord.

**Wednesday: Psalm 96**

This psalm celebrates God’s kingship over all creation. This means that all people should both love and worship the Lord. All people are called to sing to the Lord and His greatness (v. 1-6), to ascribe glory to God (v. 7-9) and know that the Lord judges in righteousness (v. 10-13). Pray that all nations would come to know the glory of the Lord and submit to His kingship overall.



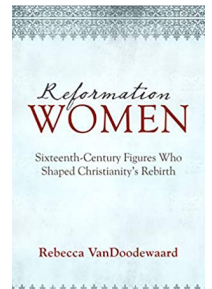


**Sermon Application**
