**Isaiah 12**

**"Life in Light of Salvation"**

1. Read v.1 and v.4. Notice the themes of thanksgiving. What is v.1 saying about thanksgiving? How is v.4 saying something slightly different? How should you respond to each of these?
2. Read v.1. Reflect on why it was appropriate for God to be angry with you prior to salvation.
3. Read v.1 Remind yourself of the comfort you felt when you first realized that God's anger toward you was absorbed by Jesus Christ.
4. What does it mean for Yahweh God to be your song (v.2)? Is He your song? If 'yes', thank Him. If 'no', confess that to Him.
5. Read v.4. How can you encourage other believers toward evangelism?
6. Read v.4 What practical ways can you commit to making God's deeds known to people this week?
7. Consider your heart today. Talk to the Lord about your answers to the following questions.
  - a) Am I happy in the Lord? Why? Why not?
  - b) Am I thankful? Why? Why not?
  - c) Do I trust the Lord right now?
  - d) Am I exuberant about my relationship with God?
  - e) What keeps me from exhorting people to praise the Lord?
  - f) What keeps me from exhorting believers to speak up for Christ?
