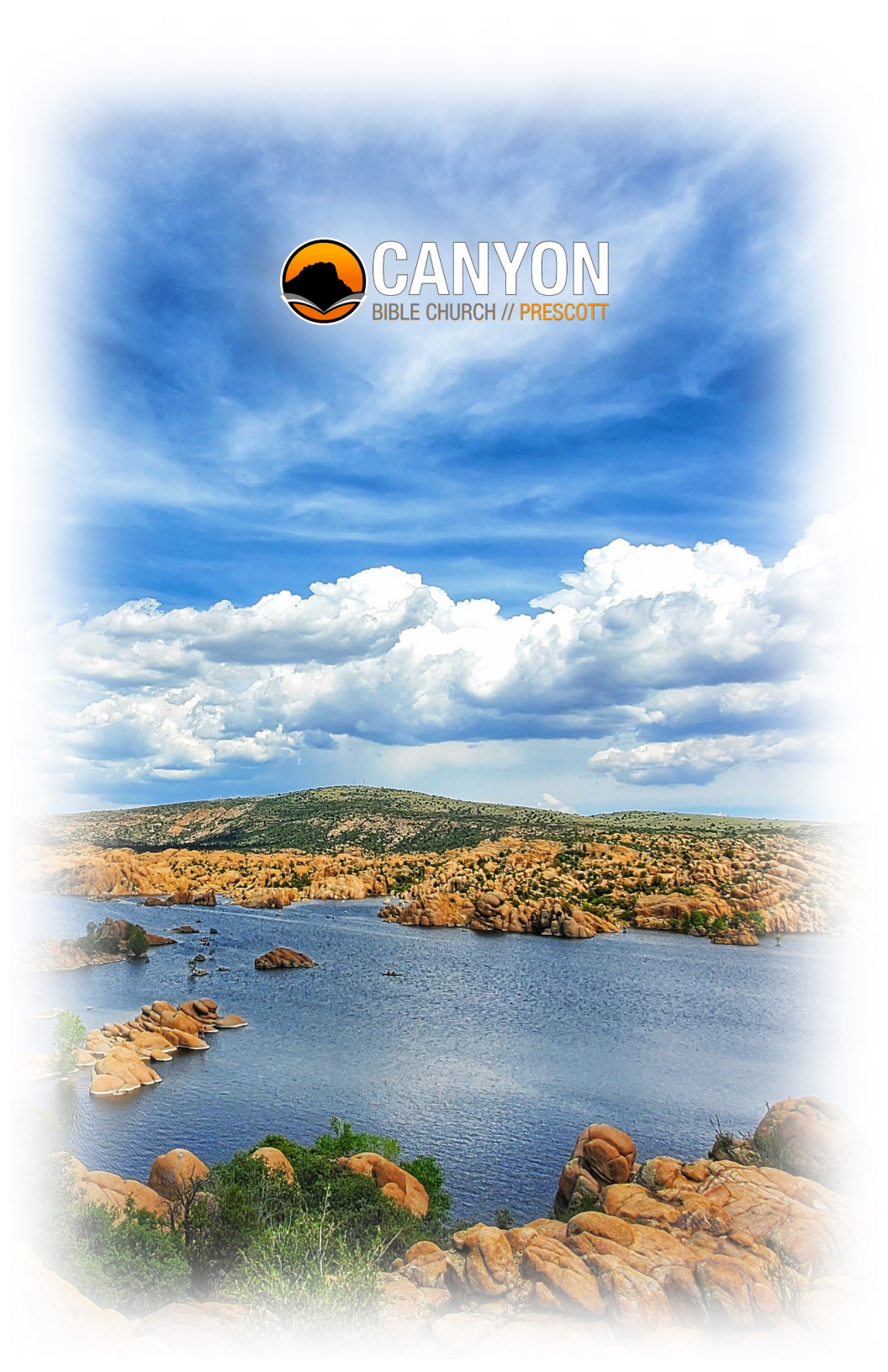

"How to Grow in the Fear of the Lord"
by Michael Reeves

"...fear of any sort is something that runs deeper than behavior: it is something in the very grain of the heart that drives behavior. Thus, sinful fear is not merely a matter of sinful actions: it hates God, despising him as a revenging Judge, and therefore acts sinfully. In contrast, a right fear loves God, cherishing him as a holy Father, and therefore has a sincere longing to be like him. And John Owen wrote similarly of the fear of the Lord as an internal inclination of the heart, disposing it to love him and delight in him above all: 'To fear the Lord and his goodness, and to fear him for his goodness; to trust in his power and faithfulness; to obey his authority; to delight in his will and grace; to love him above all, because of his excellencies and beauty;—this is to glorify him.'"
