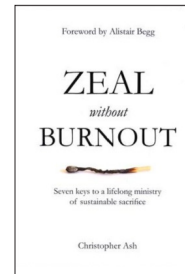

"...many of us know that it is often during trials that we come to cast ourselves more fully on the Lord.

At such times, we come to understand what our Lord taught the Apostle Paul through his own misery: "But [the Lord] said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong" (2 Cor. 12:9–10). It is often that the Lord gives and takes away because He is teaching us to wait on Him, to lean more dependently on that which can never be taken away—namely, Himself."
