Canyon on Campus at ERAU plans to meet in the Chapel on Wednesday Nights this Fall from 6-8pm for fellowship, singing, and bible study.



"We Need Restorative Rest" by Jonathan Noves

... A bow that's never unstrung cannot kill dragons. During the seventh century, the longbow became a formative weapon. However, if you wanted your

longbow to last, you would have to take the string off the bow, releasing the tension, and let it rest after the battle was over. If the bow was left in tension all the time, it would become deformed and unable to shoot arrows. The unending tension weakened the bow. The same is true of us. Unless we are regularly unstrung, the tension of our lives will weaken us to the point where we will no longer be able to slay dragons. We must have the tension of our lives unwound through rest. When we rest, we're then able to be more effective in battle. When we go without rest, not only are we unable to slay dragons, but every lizard becomes a dragon..."
