"Christians also fear death and disease. Of course. we know that we're not supposed to, and we'd never tell anyone that we harbor such fears.

Certainly, we know all the right things to say about death: God is sovereign. He has a good purpose in my pain. The Lord can teach and sanctify my family, friends, and me through the process of suffering and dying. Often, however, we say these things because we "have to" and not because we're fully convinced. I've been guilty of that.

Believers don't fear death and disease for the same reasons as non-Christians because we know Christ has a home for us in heaven (John 14:1–3). Instead, we fear losing control. We insure ourselves against property loss. We order our days so that we are most productive. By and large, we enjoy happy and fulfilling relationships by listening to others and giving of ourselves. But despite our best efforts, we can't keep death and disease away."
