

Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions May 26, 2024. Isaiah 19–20, "All-Encompassing Judgment and Salvation"

1. Read 19:1 and then Psalm 18:10. Why do you think God wants us to know that He comes quickly in these times of trouble?

2. Read 19:2. Why is the fighting between people of a nation, church, or family so disastrous? Is there any way that you are fighting with people who should be your ally? What does obedience look like in this situation?

3. Read 19:19-25. Can you think of people whom the Lord has united you to because of your Christian faith that you normally wouldn't have anything in common with?

4. Why does it glorify God for Him to bring people together who normally would not have anything in common?

5. This passage contains reasons and even a prediction of Egypt's judgment. The passage also contains a prophecy about God's salvation for people from all over the world. Examine your heart as you answer this question, "Do you focus more on the downfall and the problems of society than you focus on the fact that God is currently saving a people and building His church?"

6. How can you more faithfully be a "good news" person?
