



Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions
Isaiah 30, “The LORD Waits to Be Gracious”

1. Read 30:2 and then Deuteronomy 17:16. Why would it be such an affront to God for His people to turn to Egypt during this time?
2. Read 30:15. How would quieting our hearts and trusting the LORD be strength for us?
3. In 30:18 Isaiah says that the LORD ‘waits to be gracious to you’. Why would He wait to be gracious to His people?
4. How do you think 30:20 was fulfilled in Jesus Christ’s coming?
5. Why do you think God wanted wayward Jerusalem to know the truths found in verses 19-33?
6. One of the themes of this chapter is the unreliability of idols. Are there things \ or people in your life in which you rely too much on providing you meaning or security? If so, reflect on how those people or things are not able to do what only the Lord can do.
