

Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions and Thoughts Isaiah 38–39, "The Best of Men Are Men at Best"

- 1. Read 38:11. King Hezekiah bemoans the fact that he will not have anymore fellowship with other people on the earth. Is there any way that you are belittling the opportunities for fellowship with others?
- 2. Read 38:18-20. King Hezekiah is thankful for the opportunities to worship God and to make His faithfulness known to others. Consider your life. What would it look like for these to be greater priorities for you?
- 3. Are there leaders who you have put faith in or had great respect for who have let you down?
- 4. Would others say that you are too fascinated with any person(s)?
- 5. Take time to praise the Lord for what He has taught you about Himself.
- 6. What would it look like in your life for you to learn more about God while lessening your focus on other people?
