

Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions Isaiah 41, "How God Being Over Human History Benefits His People"

1. What do verses 5–7 teach us about the world's response to God's power?
2. What words or phrases are repeated in verses 9–20?
3. Since these words and phrases are repeated, what does that teach us about the response God desires from His people?
4. Verse 24 tells us that idols are nothing and lack power for the people who choose them. Are there people, situations, relationships, or other things in which you seek satisfaction?
5. Take a moment for a heart check. If the things you place too much hope in were to disappear, would you still thrive as a child of God?
