



Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions
Isaiah 43:22–44:23, “Revival for Spiritual Apathy”

1. Is there any way that you are acting as though God’s instructions for worship are a burden to you?

2. Consider your corporate worship (Sunday) and your daily worship. Is your heart finding satisfaction in God? If not, why?

3. Read 44:3. God promises to give His Spirit to a future people. This prophecy is fulfilled in believers today. What benefit is the Holy Spirit to your everyday life?

4. Read 44:8. Why do you think God contrasts Himself with idols by referring to Himself as our “Rock”?

5. Idolatry happens when we depend on a person, situation, or an item to bring us a satisfaction that will permeate all of our lives. We know intellectually that only God can bring this satisfaction. However, it’s good to identify ways that we’re tempted toward idolatry. What is something that you can be tempted to idolize?

6. Read 44:22 Notice that God calls a people back to Him who have been redeemed. If you’ve been apathetic as a worshiper, what are some truths about your relationship with God that would be worth reflecting on or talking to somebody else about?
