1. Read 48:3-5. Why did God tell His people the things that have happened in the past before they even happened?

2. Read 48:6-8. Why does God tell His people that He's not going to specifically tell them what will happen in the future?

3. Read 48:9-11. How would you answer somebody who told you they didn't want to be a Christian because of how much Christians suffer?

4. Read 48:17-20. What are some of the blessings for obedience that God gives to us?

5. How are children blessed when parents walk in obedience to the Lord?

6. Read 48:20-21. This passage is about God's rescue of His people from Babylon. What does He want those rescued people to understand about their new life?

7. Read 48:22. Why do you think God ends this section with a warning like this?
