



Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions
Isaiah 53:4–6, “Pierced for Our Transgressions”

1. If we are going to appreciate the cross of Jesus Christ rightly, then we must have a grasp on the depth of our sinfulness. Take time to think about why Jesus needed to die for you. How offensive were you to God?

2. Verse five teaches us that Jesus died for us in a holistic manner. When we receive salvation, God makes us whole in every way. We will one day be healed physically of every infirmity. We do not have our sins credited to us. We are no longer considered rebellious, and our enmity with God is a thing of the past. Which of these realities do you need to reflect on most today?

3. Is there any way that you have been straying from the Lord? Is there any area of His Lordship that you are balking at?

4. Which one of the songs in today’s worship gathering can you choose to turn into a prayer of praise this week? Ask the Lord to give you fresh eyes to see and sing about the wonder of the cross.
