Suggested Sermon Discussion Questions

Isaiah 63:15–64:12, “A Desperate Request to a Father”

1. How do you respond when you see spiritual decline around you? Does it move you to lament, to intercede, or to withdraw?
2. Isaiah includes himself as he confesses the sins of the people of God. When you think of the problems of the people of God today, which of your sins are included in them?
3. Why do you think Isaiah tells God that He is the potter and we are the clay?
4. Which features of this prayer do you find lacking in your own prayer life?
5. Isaiah—and later Jesus—pray to God as Father. Why is it important to pray to God as Father?
