What do I learn about God?

Christ's rule is consistent with His character.

Is there anything for which I should repent based on this text?

Do I trust Christ to rule my life like this passage says He does? Do I question him? Do I doubt that these attributes are actually true of Him?

How might God use this passage to make me look more like Christ?

As Christ lives/rules in a way that is consistent with His character, it is important for me to understand that I've been indwelt by the Holy Spirit as well. I am to live in a way that reflects my new life in Christ.

How does this passage affect evangelism?

We are able to show people what a life lived under Christ's rule looks like. People should know what kind of King they are called to submit to.

How can I edify the church based on what this passage says?

I can point my brothers and sisters to the capable rule of Christ in their lives.
