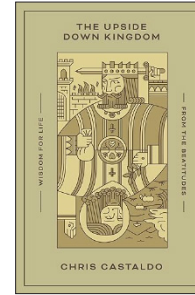

by Chris Castaldo



"*The Upside Down Kingdom* is a guided tour through Jesus' Beatitudes in Matthew 5. Here, we see that the values of Christ's kingdom are radically different from the values of the world. Where the world prizes strength, success, self-promotion, and comfort, Jesus calls his people to humility, mercy, purity, peacemaking, and faithfulness in suffering. The book helps readers see that true blessedness is found not in worldly achievement, but in living under the gracious rule of King Jesus."

### Weekly Resource

"Do You Care About the Widows?"  
by RC Sproul

"The Apostle James focuses on religion as the practice of those who have true faith in Jesus, and he says that true religion demonstrates the presence of saving trust in the Lord (James 2:14-26). What true godliness looks like, he tells us, is not a matter of merely holding to right doctrine with our minds, though that is essential. No, true godliness means that doctrine shapes our lives to such a degree that we manifest the kind of life God wants us to live. And James gives us a succinct definition of true religion, of true godliness: "Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: To visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world." James elevates the activity of caring for widows and orphans as the very essence of pure and undefiled religion. That strikes me as being very significant, and it's an idea that is neglected in the church today."

## The London Baptist Confession of 1689

### XXXII. Of the Last Judgment

1. God hath appointed a Day wherein he will judge the world in Righteousness, by <sup>a</sup>Jesus Christ; to whom all power and judgment is given of the Father; in which Day not only the <sup>b</sup>Apostate Angels shall be judged; but likewise all persons that have lived upon the Earth, shall appear before the Tribunal of Christ; <sup>c</sup>to give an account of their Thoughts, Words, and Deeds, and to receive according to what they have done in the body, whether good or evil.

2. The end of God's appointing this Day, is for the manifestation of the glory of his Mercy, in the Eternal Salvation of the Elect; <sup>a</sup>and of his Justice in the Eternal damnation of the Reprobate, who are wicked and disobedient; for then shall the Righteous go into Everlasting Life, and receive that fullness of Joy, and Glory, with everlasting reward, in the presence <sup>b</sup>of the Lord: but the wicked who know not God, and obey not the Gospel of Jesus Christ, shall be cast into Eternal torments, and <sup>c</sup>punished with everlasting destruction, from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power.

3. As Christ would have us to be certainly persuaded that there shall be a Day of judgment, both <sup>a</sup>to deter all men from sin, and for the greater <sup>b</sup>consolation of the godly, in their adversity; so will he have that day unknown to Men, that they may shake off all carnal security, and be always watchful, because they know not at what hour, the <sup>c</sup>Lord will come; and may ever be prepared to say, <sup>d</sup>Come Lord Jesus, Come quickly, Amen.
