PASSAGE DISCUSSION

1 Timothy 6:11-21

"Take Hold of Eternal Life!"

1. Why do you think it was important for Timothy to remember that Jesus Christ is returning?
2. Verse 11 tells Timothy to flee sin and also to pursue righteousness. In which of these areas do you need growth?
3. What does it look like to fight the good fight of faith, but to also be gentle?
4. Has God placed you in an environment where you should be defending the faith?
5. Assess your generosity. Where is there room for growth? What can you practically do to obey the words of vv.17-19?
