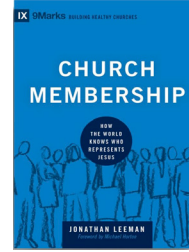

“Did Paul Endorse Slavery?”

by Denny Burk

“... 1 Timothy 6:1–2, Paul is not making a statement about systemic injustices and social inequality. Nor is he intending to offer a moral evaluation of the institution of slavery. Rather, he is instructing Christian slaves about how they are to follow Christ in the situation in which they find themselves. Faithfulness to Christ does not require slaves to mount an armed rebellion against their oppressors, nor does it require them to pursue a massive reformation of the institution of slavery. These kinds of opportunities were not available to slaves in the Greco-Roman world, and modern readers need to be careful not to read their own democratic expectations into the strictures of a first-century slave’s life. Paul seeks to spell out for the slaves in the congregation how they may remain faithful to Christ in a very difficult situation.”
