Elementary (4-11 y/o): "Peter and John Preach the Gospel" - Acts 3:1-26

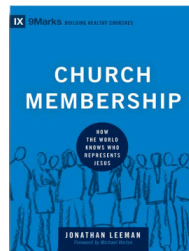

"Spiritual Growth is Not an Accident"

by Jon Bloom

"We are all "plants," and we are all "gardeners." Gardening is, after all, the original job God gave to man when he "put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it" (Genesis 2:15). Like Adam and Eve,

God has given us "gardens" to tend, and he expects us to work and keep them. And the work we do really matters to the condition of the gardens.

What gardens has he given you? And as the quite contrary Mary was asked in the nursery rhyme, "How do your gardens grow?" What have you planted? For a plant only comes forth from a planted seed. How are you nurturing what's been planted? For gardening requires persistent, diligent work."

PASSAGE DISCUSSION

2 Peter 1:3-11

"Grace that Produces Growth"

1. Peter says God has given believers “everything we need for life and godliness.” What are some situations where you are tempted to believe that God’s provision is not enough?
2. What is the difference between merely knowing facts about God and truly knowing God relationally? How can you tell the difference in your own life?
3. Peter calls believers to “make every effort” in spiritual growth. Why do Christians sometimes drift toward either passivity (“let go and let God”) or self-reliance? Which tendency do you struggle with more?
4. Which of the qualities in verses 5–7 most needs growth in your life right now (self-control, steadfastness, brotherly affection, love, etc.)? Why?
5. Peter connects spiritual growth with assurance. How does ongoing growth and repentance help strengthen confidence in your relationship with Christ?
6. What practical habits or rhythms help cultivate spiritual growth in everyday life? What tends to hinder or distract you from pursuing godliness?

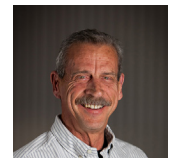

The 1689 London Baptist Confession

I. Of the Holy Scriptures

3. The Books commonly called Apocrypha not being of ^aDivine inspiration, are no part of the Canon (or rule) of the Scripture, and therefore are of no authority to the Church of God, nor to be any otherwise approved or made use of, then other human writings.

^aLuke 24:27, 44; Rom. 3:2

4. The Authority of the Holy Scripture for which it ought to be believed dependeth not upon the testimony of any man, or Church; but wholly upon ^aGod (who is truth itself) the Author thereof; therefore it is to be received, because it is the Word of God.

^a2 Pet. 1:19–21; 2 Tim. 3:16; 2 Thess. 2:13; 1 John 5:9

5. We may be moved and induced by the testimony of the Church of God, to an high and reverent esteem of the Holy Scriptures; and the heavenliness of the matter, the efficacy of the Doctrine, and the Majesty of the style, the consent of all the parts, the scope of the whole (which is to give all glory to God) the full discovery it makes of the only way of man's salvation, and many other incomparable Excellencies, and entire perfections thereof, are arguments whereby it doth abundantly evidence itself to be the Word of God; yet notwithstanding; our ^afull persuasion, and assurance of the infallible truth, and divine authority thereof, is from the inward work of the Holy Spirit, bearing witness by and with the Word in our Hearts.
