You (Still) Need the Gospel

“The gospel tells us that we’ve been regenerated. That’s a big word that points to an even bigger reality: Christians — those of us united to Jesus by faith — have been given brand-new spiritual abilities, thanks to what Jesus has done for us in his death, burial, and resurrection. We have brand-new powers. Paul calls these powers “incomparably great” (Ephesians 1:19). I like to think of them as superpowers. The gospel takes skinny little Steve Rogers and turns him — you — into Captain America. The gospel takes sinners like you and me and turns us into saints.”

PASSAGE DISCUSSION

2 Peter 3:1-7

"Don't Forget the End"

1. Peter says one of the greatest needs of mature believers is to be reminded of truths they already know (v. 1-2). Why do you think we so easily “forget” the gospel and God’s promises?
2. Peter tells believers to remember both the Old Testament prophets and the teaching of Christ passed down through the apostles. What does this teach us about the authority and sufficiency of Scripture? How should that shape the way we respond to competing voices in our culture?
3. According to verses 3-4, what motivated the scoffers’ rejection of Christ’s return? Why is it important that Peter connects their false doctrine with their sinful desires?
4. Peter says the scoffers “deliberately overlook” God’s work in creation and the flood (v. 5-6). What is the difference between lacking evidence and refusing to acknowledge evidence? How have you seen this distinction play out in conversations?
5. Peter points to God’s past faithfulness as assurance of His future promises. How has remembering God’s faithfulness in your own life strengthened your confidence during seasons of waiting or uncertainty?
6. If you were fully convinced that Christ could return at any time, what would change about your priorities, your relationships, or your pursuit of holiness this week?

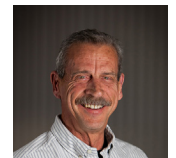

The 1689 London Baptist Confession

II. Of God and of the Holy Trinity

2. God having all ^alife, ^bglory, ^cgoodness, blessedness, in and of himself: is alone in, and unto himself all-sufficient, not ^dstanding in need of any Creature which he hath made, nor deriving any glory from them, but only manifesting his own glory in, by, unto, and upon them, he is the alone fountain of all Being, ^eof whom, through whom, and to whom are all things, and he hath most sovereign ^fdominion over all creatures, to do by them, for them, or upon them, whatsoever himself pleaseth; in his sight ^gall things are open and manifest, his knowledge is ^hinfinite, infallible, and independent upon the Creature, so as nothing is to him contingent, or uncertain; he is most holy in all his Counsels, in ⁱall his Works, and in all his Commands; to him is due ^jfrom Angels and men, whatsoever worship, service, or obedience as Creatures they owe unto the Creator, and whatever he is further pleased to require of them.

3. In this divine and infinite Being there are three subsistences, ^athe Father, the Word (or Son), and Holy Spirit, of one substance, power, and Eternity, each having the whole Divine Essence, ^byet the Essence undivided, the Father is of none neither begotten nor proceeding, the Son is ^cEternally begotten of the Father, the holy Spirit ^dproceeding from the Father and the Son, all infinite, without beginning, there fore but one God, who is not to be divided in nature and Being; but distinguished by several peculiar, relative properties, and personal relations; which doctrine of the Trinity is the foundation of all our Communion with God, and comfortable dependence on him.
