We know time with them is precious, and it is a privilege for us to partner with you in their evangelism and discipleship.

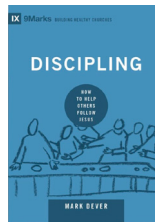
Here are our lessons for today, so you may continue talking about them *as you walk by the way*, and at home this week:

Discipling . . . *How to Help Others Follow Jesus* by Mark Dever

In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus gives his followers a clear mission to go and make disciples of all nations - this included baptizing them and teaching them to observe all that he commanded.

A disciple of Jesus is one who is maturing in their faith. In this book, author and pastor Mark Dever gives a basic definition of what "discipling" means - it is helping others to follow Jesus, or deliberately doing spiritual good to someone so that he or she will become more like Christ. In the New Testament, discipling is not optional: it is basic.

In the context of the local church, pastors and members alike, are called to make disciples by seeking to serve others sacrificially, inviting / "folding" them into everyday life events, asking the Lord to transform our lives, and continually pointing God's people to biblical truth.

"Live Against the Drift" *Refocusing the Distracted Soul* by Marshall Segal

"The danger of drifting, spiritual or otherwise, is in just how subtle and comfortable drifting can feel. Often we don't even notice it's happening at all.

One mark of Christian maturity is learning that none of us passively drifts toward Christ, not even after we've followed him for years or even decades. The currents of the still-sinful soul, weathered by constant waves of temptation, still pull us out to sea. We can't sluggishly float in place. We're either swimming toward God or drifting somewhere else."

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The 1689 London Baptist Confession

III. Of God's Decree

4. These Angels and Men thus predestinated, and foreordained, are particularly, and unchangeably designed; and their number so certain, and definite, that it cannot be either increased, or diminished.

^a2 Tim. 2:19; John 13:18

5. Those of mankind ^athat are predestinated to life, God before the foundation of the world was laid, according to his eternal and immutable purpose, and the secret Counsel and good pleasure of his will, hath chosen in Christ unto everlasting glory, out of his mere free grace and love; ^bwithout any other thing in the creature as a condition or cause moving him thereunto.

6. As God hath appointed the Elect unto glory, so he hath by the eternal and most free purpose of his will, foreordained ^aall the means thereunto, wherefore they who are elected, being fallen in Adam, ^bare redeemed by Christ, are effectually ^ccalled unto faith in Christ, by his spirit working in due season, are justified, adopted, sanctified, and kept by his power through faith ^dunto salvation; neither are any other redeemed by Christ, or effectually called, justified, adopted, sanctified, and saved, but the Elect ^eonly.

The Doctrine of this high mystery of predestination, is to be handled with special prudence, and care; that men attending the will of God revealed in his word, and yielding obedience thereunto, may from the certainty of their effectual vocation, be assured of their ^aeternal election; so shall this doctrine afford matter ^bof praise, reverence, and admiration of God, and ^cof humility, diligence, and abundant ^dconsolation, to all that sincerely obey the Gospel.
