We know time with them is precious, and it is a privilege for us to partner with you in their evangelism and discipleship.

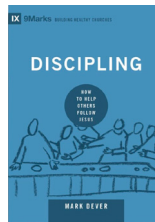
Here are our lessons for today, so you may continue talking about them *as you walk by the way*, and at home this week:

Discipling . . . *How to Help Others Follow Jesus* by Mark Dever

In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus gives his followers a clear mission to go and make disciples of all nations - this included baptizing them and teaching them to observe all that he commanded.

A disciple of Jesus is one who is maturing in their faith. In this book, author and pastor Mark Dever gives a basic definition of what “discipling” means - it is helping others to follow Jesus, or deliberately doing spiritual good to someone so that he or she will become more like Christ. In the New Testament, discipling is not optional: it is basic.

In the context of the local church, pastors and members alike, are called to make disciples by seeking to serve others sacrificially, inviting / “folding” them into everyday life events, asking the Lord to transform our lives, and continually pointing God’s people to biblical truth.

This book is one of my favorite resources with respect to helping Christians understand what it means to make disciples of Jesus, who make other disciples of Jesus.” ~ Pastor Rod

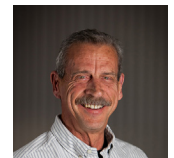

The 1689 London Baptist Confession

IV. Of Creation

1. In the beginning it pleased God the Father, ^aSon, and Holy Spirit, for the manifestation of the glory of ^bhis eternal power, wisdom, and goodness, to Create or make the world, and all things therein, ^cwhether visible or invisible, in the space of six days, and all very good.

^aJohn 1:2–3, Heb. 1:2, Job 26:13; ^bRom. 1:20; ^cCol. 1:16, Gen. 2:1–2

2. After God had made all other Creatures, he Created ^aman, male and female, with ^breasonable and immortal souls, rendering them fit unto that life to God; for which they were Created; being ^cmade after the image of God, in knowledge, righteousness, and true holiness; having the Law of God ^dwritten in their hearts, and power to fulfill it; and yet under a possibility of transgressing, being left to the liberty of their own will, which was ^esubject to change.

^aGen. 1:27; ^bGen. 2:7; ^cEccles. 7:29, Gen. 1:26; ^dRom. 2:14–15; ^eGen. 3:6

3. Besides the Law written in their hearts, they received ^aa command not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil; which whilst they kept, they were happy in their Communion with God, and had dominion ^bover the Creatures.
