XXVI. Of the Church

4. The Lord Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church, in whom by the appointment of the Father, ^aall power for the calling, institution, order, or Government of the Church, is invested in a supreme and sovereign manner, neither can the Pope of Rome* in any sense be head thereof, but is ^bthat Antichrist, that Man of sin, and Son of perdition, that exalteth himself in the Church against Christ, and all that is called God; whom the Lord shall destroy with the brightness of his coming.





"It happens with alarming, distressing regularity. And it hurts every time. It hurts every time we see a person we love or admire fall into a great sin or deny a precious doctrine. We are always left asking ourselves how it happened. What went wrong? How did we not see this coming? How did they not see this coming?"

Every one of these situations is unique and uniquely complicated. And yet there is always an inevitable, terrible simplicity as well. These people failed to carry out a simple task. They failed to maintain an effective self-watch. When Paul wrote to Timothy he said, "keep a close watch on yourself and on the teaching"—keep a close watch on how you behave and on what you believe.
