

The London Baptist Confession of 1689

XX. Of the Gospel, and of the Extent of the Grace thereof

1. The Covenant of Works being broken by Sin, and made unprofitable unto Life; God was pleased to give forth the promise of Christ, ^athe Seed of the Woman, as the means of calling the Elect, and begetting in them Faith and Repentance; in this Promise, the ^bGospel, as to the substance of it, was revealed, and therein Effectual, for the Conversion and Salvation of Sinners.

2. This Promise of Christ, and Salvation by him, is revealed only by ^athe Word of God; neither do the Works of Creation, or Providence, with the light of Nature, ^bmake discovery of Christ, or of Grace by him; so much as in a general, or obscure way; much less that men destitute of the Revelation of him by the Promise, or Gospel; ^cshould be enabled thereby, to attain saving Faith, or Repentance.



3. The Revelation of the Gospel unto Sinners, made in divers times, and by sundry parts; with the addition of Promises, and Precepts for the Obedience required therein, as to the Nations, and Persons, to whom it is granted, is merely of the ^aSovereign Will and good Pleasure of God; not being annexed by virtue of any Promise, to the due improvement of men's natural abilities, by virtue of Common light received, without it; which none ever did ^bmake, or can so do: And therefore in all Ages the preaching of the Gospel hath been granted unto persons and Nations, as to the extent, or straitening of it, in great variety, according to the Counsel of the Will of God.

Although the Gospel be the only outward means, of revealing Christ, and saving Grace; and is, as such, abundantly sufficient there unto; yet that men who are dead in Trespases, may be born again, Quickened or Regenerated; there is moreover necessary, an effectual, insuperable ^awork of the Holy Spirit, upon the whole Soul, for the producing in them a new spiritual Life; without which no other means will effect ^btheir Conversion unto God.

Ministry Highlight: Safety Team



Remember Death: The Surprising Path to Living Hope
by Matthew McCullough

"Matthew McCullough's *Remember Death: The Surprising Path to Living Hope* reminds believers that facing our mortality isn't morbid—it's liberating. Remembering that life is fleeting humbles our pride, loosens our grip on possessions and status, and deepens our joy in Christ. Death tells the truth about our limits, but the gospel tells a greater truth: Jesus has conquered the grave, so our hope is not vague optimism but solid assurance—because He lives, we also will live. This awareness transforms ordinary life, teaching us to love people better, suffer with patience, and hold earthly things lightly. Far from gloomy, McCullough's message is bright with encouragement: when we learn to remember death, we begin to live fully—anchored in the risen Christ, grateful for today, and confident in the life to come."

"Today, too, Jesus calls each of us to follow him. And wrapped up in the call to follow him is the call to follow those who are like him. We imitate Jesus by imitating people who are like Jesus. We are influenced by Jesus by being influenced by people who have themselves been influenced by Jesus. "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ," said Paul (1 Corinthians 11:1).

In Jesus's day students would become followers of a teacher they encountered in real life, someone they followed both literally and figuratively, someone they knew and were known by. Surely, then, they took very seriously the decision of whom they would follow."
