XIX. Of the Law of God

3. Besides this Law commonly called moral, God was pleased to give to the people of Israel Ceremonial Laws, containing several typical ordinances, partly of worship, ^aprefiguring Christ, his graces, actions, sufferings, and benefits; and partly holding forth divers instructions ^bof moral duties, all which Ceremonial Laws being appointed only to the time of reformation, are by Jesus Christ the true Messiah and only Lawgiver who was furnished with power from the Father, for that end, ^cabrogated and taken away.





Remember Death: The Surprising Path to Living Hope

"Matthew McCullough's *Remember Death: The Surprising Path to Living Hope* reminds believers that facing our mortality isn't morbid—it's liberating. Remembering that life is fleeting humbles our pride, loosens our grip on possessions and status, and deepens our joy in Christ. Death tells the truth about our limits, but the gospel tells a greater truth: Jesus has conquered the grave, so our hope is not vague optimism but solid assurance—because He lives, we also will live. This awareness transforms ordinary life, teaching us to love people better, suffer with patience, and hold earthly things lightly. Far from gloomy, McCullough's message is bright with encouragement: when we learn to remember death, we begin to live fully—anchored in the risen Christ, grateful for today, and confident in the life to come."

Good works are deeds that are done not first for your own good but for the good of others. You are called to put aside the natural selfishness that once controlled you and to put on the Christ-like selflessness that compels you to bless others. You are to live as a good-works extremist, a man who will stop at nothing to be a blessing to others. "We are [God's] workmanship," says Paul, "created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them" (Ephesians 2:10)."
