
### **XIX. Of the Law of God**

6. Although true Believers be not under the Law, as a Covenant of Works, <sup>a</sup>to be thereby Justified or condemned; yet it is of great use to them as well as to others: in that, as a Rule of Life, informing them of the Will of God, and their Duty, it directs and binds them, to walk accordingly; <sup>b</sup>discovering also the sinful pollutions of their Natures, Hearts and Lives; so as Examining themselves thereby, they may come to further Conviction of, Humiliation for, and Hatred against Sin; together with a clearer sight of the need they have of Christ and the perfection of his Obedience: It is likewise of use to the Regenerate to restrain their Corruptions, in that it forbids Sin; and the Threatenings of it serve to show what even their Sins deserve; and what afflictions in this Life they may expect for them, although freed from the Curse and unallayed Rigor thereof. The Promises of it likewise show them God's approbation of Obedience, and what blessings they may expect upon the performance thereof, though not as due to them by the Law as a Covenant of Works; so as man's doing Good and refraining from Evil, because the Law encourageth to the one and deterreth from the other, is no Evidence of his being <sup>c</sup>under the Law and not under Grace.

Neither are the forementioned uses of the Law <sup>a</sup>contrary to the Grace of the Gospel; but do sweetly comply with it; the Spirit of Christ subduing <sup>b</sup>and enabling the Will of man, to do that freely and cheer fully, which the will of God revealed in the Law, requireth to be done.



by Matthew McCullough

"Matthew McCullough's *Remember Death: The Surprising Path to Living Hope* reminds believers that facing our mortality isn't morbid—it's liberating. Remembering that life is fleeting humbles our pride, loosens our grip on possessions and status, and deepens our joy in Christ. Death tells the truth about our limits, but the gospel tells a greater truth: Jesus has conquered the grave, so our hope is not vague optimism but solid assurance—because He lives, we also will live. This awareness transforms ordinary life, teaching us to love people better, suffer with patience, and hold earthly things lightly. Far from gloomy, McCullough's message is bright with encouragement: when we learn to remember death, we begin to live fully—anchored in the risen Christ, grateful for today, and confident in the life to come."

"Yet even amidst the gloom of the gathering shadow, all is not lost. For in the thickest of tempests, as sin and Satan swirl about, the Lord is ever upon His throne—unphased and unbothered. Even the Devil himself is still God's Devil, and on a leash at that. And because Jesus sits enthroned as King of kings and Lord of lords, the news of His return is ever upon the lips of His people.
