



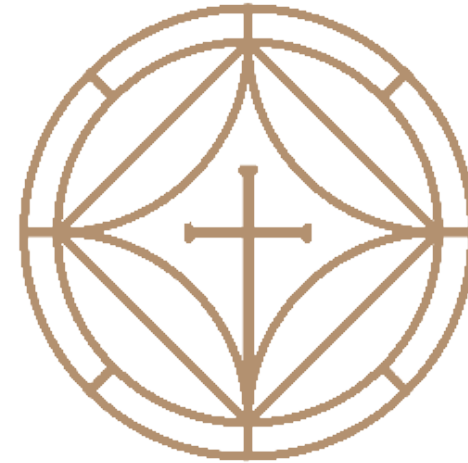
**XXX. Of The Lord's Table**

4. The denial of the Cup to the people, worshiping the Elements, the lifting them up, or carrying them about for adoration, and reserving them for any pretended religious use, <sup>a</sup>are all contrary to the nature of this Ordinance, and to the institution of Christ.

5. The outward Elements in this Ordinance, duly set apart to the uses ordained by Christ, have such relation to him crucified, as that truly, although in terms used figuratively, they are sometimes called by the name of the things they represent, to wit the <sup>a</sup>body and Blood of Christ; albeit in substance, and nature, they still remain truly, and only <sup>b</sup>Bread, and Wine, as they were before.

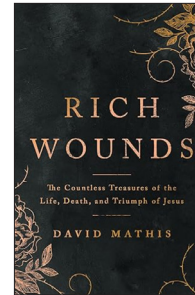
