

The London Baptist Confession of 1689

V. Of God's Divine Providence

1. God the good Creator of all things, in his infinite power, and wisdom, doth ^auphold, direct, dispose, and govern all Creatures, and things, from the greatest even to the ^bleast, by his most wise and holy providence, to the end for the which they were Created; according unto his infallible foreknowledge, and the free and immutable Counsel of his ^cown will; to the praise of the glory of his wisdom, power, justice, infinite goodness and mercy.

2. Although in relation to the foreknowledge and Decree of God, the first cause, all things come to pass ^aimmutably and infallibly; so that there is not anything, befalls any ^bby chance, or without his Providence; yet by the same Providence he ordereth them to fall out, according to the nature of second causes, either ^cnecessarily, freely, or contingently.

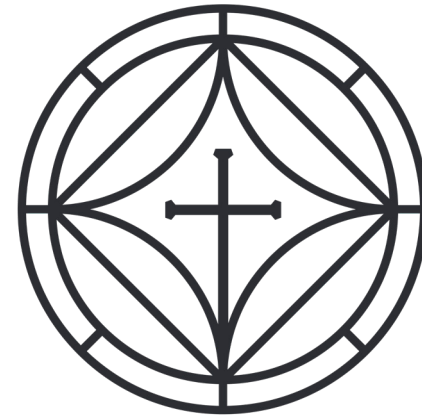

3. God in his ordinary Providence ^amaketh use of means; yet is free ^bto work, without, ^cabove, and ^dagainst them at his pleasure.

The Almighty power, unsearchable wisdom, and infinite goodness of God, so far manifest themselves in his Providence, that his determinate Counsel ^aextendeth itself even to the first fall, and all other sinful actions both of Angels, and Men; (and that not by a bare permission) which also he most wisely and powerfully ^bboundeth, and otherwise ordereth, and governeth, in a manifold dispensation to his most holy ^cends: yet so, as the sinfulness of their acts proceedeth only from the Creatures, and not from God; who being most holy and righteous, neither is nor can be, the author or ^dapprover of sin.

"One of my favorite metaphors is one we find in Paul's epistles—the picture of Christians, of the church, as a body. A human body is made up of many parts, each of which has its own function, and each of which is integral to the functioning of the whole.
