



## *The London Baptist Confession of 1689*

### VI. Of the Fall of Man, of Sin, and of the Punishment Thereof

1. Although God created Man upright, and perfect, and gave him a righteous law, which had been unto life had he kept it, <sup>a</sup>and threatened death upon the breach thereof; yet he did not long abide in this honor; <sup>b</sup>Satan using the subtlety of the serpent to seduce Eve, then by her seducing Adam, who without any compulsion, did willfully transgress the Law of their Creation, and the command given unto them, in eating the forbidden fruit; which God was pleased according to his wise and holy Counsel to permit, having purposed to order it, to his own glory.

2. Our first Parents by this Sin, fell from their <sup>a</sup>original righteousness and communion with God, and we in them, whereby death came upon all; <sup>b</sup>all becoming dead in Sin, and wholly defiled, <sup>c</sup>in all the faculties, and parts, of soul, and body.

3. They being the <sup>a</sup>root, and by God's appointment, standing in the room, and stead of all mankind; the guilt of the Sin was imputed, and corrupted nature conveyed, to all their posterity descending from them by ordinary generation, being now <sup>b</sup>conceived in Sin, and by nature children <sup>c</sup>of wrath, the servants of Sin, the subjects <sup>d</sup>of death and all other miseries, spiritual, temporal and eternal, unless the Lord Jesus <sup>e</sup>set them free.

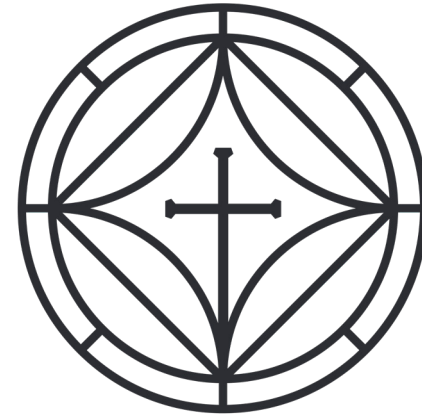

### Nursing Mothers' Room

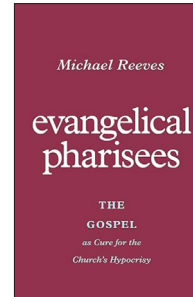
