VII. Of Christ the Mediator

1. It pleased God in his eternal purpose, to choose and ordain the Lord Jesus his only begotten Son, according to the Covenant made between them both, ato be the Mediator between God and Man; the Prophet, Priest and King; Head and Savior of his Church, the heir of all things, and judge of the world: Unto whom he did from all Eternity give a people to be his seed, and to be by him in time redeemed, called, justified, sanctified, and glorified.

2. The Son of God, the second Person in the Holy Trinity, being very and eternal God, the brightness of the Father's glory, of one substance and equal with him: who made the World, who upholdeth and governeth all things he hath made: did when the fullness of time was come take unto him aman's nature, with all the Essential properties, and common infirmities thereof, byet without sin: being conceived by the Holy Spirit in the Womb of the Virgin Mary, the Holy Spirit coming down upon her, and the power of the most High overshadowing her, and so was made of a Woman, of the Tribe of Judah, of the Seed of Abraham, and David according to the Scriptures: So that two whole, perfect, and distinct natures, were inseparably joined together in one Person: without conversion, composition, or confusion: which Person is very God, and very Man; yet one dChrist, the only Mediator between God and



The Lord Jesus in his human nature thus united to the divine, in the Person of the Son, was sanctified, and anointed awith the Holy Spirit, above measure; having in him ball the treasures of wisdom and knowledge; in whom it pleased the Father that call fullness should dwell: To the end that being dholy, harmless, undefiled, and full cof Grace, and Truth, he might be thoroughly furnished to execute the Office of a Mediator, and Surety; which Office he took not upon himself, but was thereunto called by his Father; who also put hall power and judgment in his hand, and gave him Commandment to execute the same

Welcome Center


