VIII. Of Christ the Mediator

4. This Office the Lord Jesus did most ^awillingly undertake, which that he might discharge he was made under the Law, ^band did perfectly fulfill it, and underwent the ^cpunishment due to us, which we should have born and suffered, being made ^dSin and a Curse for us: enduring most grievous sorrows ^ein his Soul; and most painful sufferings in his body; was crucified, and died, and remained in the state of the dead; yet saw no ^fcorruption: on the ^gthird day he arose from the dead, with the same ^hbody in which he suffered; with which he also ⁱascended into heaven: and there sitteth at the right hand of his Father, ^jmaking intercession; and shall ^kreturn to judge Men and Angels, at the end of the World.

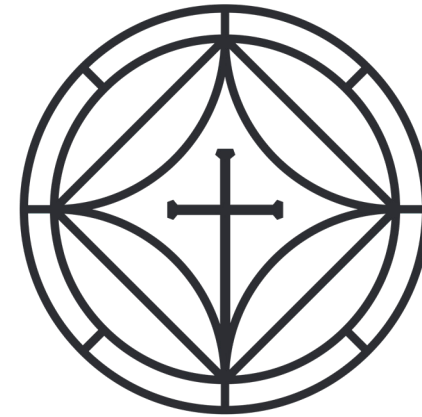
