

The London Baptist Confession of 1689

XI. Of Justification

1. Those whom God Effectually calleth, he also freely ^ajustifieth, not by infusing Righteousness into them, but by ^bpardoning their sins, and by accounting, and accepting their Persons as ^cRighteous; not for anything wrought in them, or done by them, but for Christ's sake alone, not by imputing faith itself, the act of believing, or any other ^devangelical obedience to them, as their Righteousness; but by imputing Christ's active obedience unto the whole Law, and passive obedience in his death, for their whole and sole Righteousness, they ^ereceiving, and resting on him, and his Righteousness, by Faith; which faith they have not of themselves, it is the gift of God.

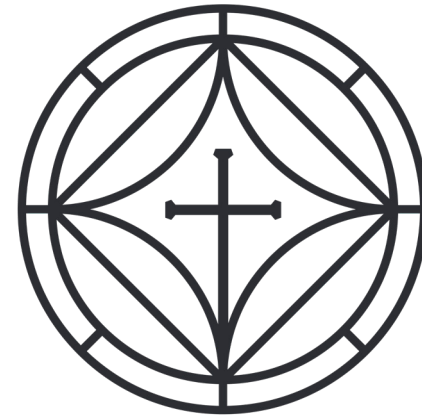

2. Faith thus receiving and resting on Christ, and his Righteousness, is the ^aalone instrument of Justification: yet it is not alone in the person justified, but is ever accompanied with all other saving Graces, and is no dead faith, ^bbut worketh by love.

3. Christ by his obedience, and death, did fully discharge the debt of all those that are justified; and did by the sacrifice of himself, in the blood of his cross, undergoing in their stead, the penalty due unto them: make a proper, real and full satisfaction ^ato God's justice in their behalf: yet inasmuch as he was given by the Father for them, and his Obedience and Satisfaction accepted in their stead, and both ^bfreely, not for anything in them; their Justification is only of Free Grace, that both the exact justice and rich Grace of God, might be ^cglorified in the Justification of sinners.

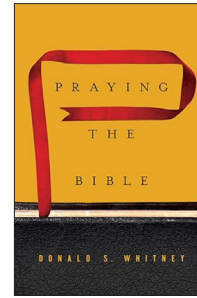

3. Why do you think Isaiah tells God that He is the potter and we are the clay?
4. Which features of this prayer do you find lacking in your own prayer life?
5. Isaiah—and later Jesus—pray to God as Father. Why is it important to pray to God as Father?
